

Teaching Fellow Positions in Economics at Ashoka University

Applications are invited for the position of Teaching Fellow (TF) for economics courses for Spring 2025. Subject to budgetary approval and performance, the contract may be extended to the next academic year as well.

Applicants must have completed Masters in Economics from a reputable institution. They must exhibit proficiency in at least two subjects from the list of compulsory undergraduate economics courses: Mathematics for Economics, Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Statistics and Econometrics. Applicants who exhibit strong skills in graduate level subjects on the same topics will be given higher consideration.

The duties of a TF include attending the lectures, helping the professor with grading and other logistics, in addition to leading discussion sessions (DS) per section each week. In DSs and during office hours a TF is expected to help students understand the ideas and concepts introduced in the course, develop problem-solving skills, and, in general, enlarge the intellectual imagination of the students.

The TFs form part of the intellectual community of Ashoka University, which includes a number of outstanding researchers and a vibrant student community. The appointment will be for the academic year starting from the third week of January 2025. The contract offers an attractive salary. Ashoka helps TFs find accommodation in apartments in the neighbourhood of the university.

Please apply for the position only if you are available to work on-site at Ashoka campus. TFs are expected to be on campus at least four days a week.

All applications received before December 10, 2024 will receive full consideration. Applications received after December 10, 2024 will be considered if vacancies exist. 1. Cover letter expressing interest and clearly stating ranking in terms of preference and competence to be a teaching assistant for courses in the following fields: Microeconomics (including mathematical economics), Macroeconomics, Statistics and Econometrics, and Finance.

3. Undergraduate and graduate transcripts
4. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member who has taught the candidate at the graduate level (Masters/MPhil/PhD). We require one letter of recommendation for the candidate. The recommender should email their reference letter to **Ms. Heena Arya** (heena.arya@ashoka.edu.in).
