

**Job Title:** Project Associate on the project, "Towards a National Cultural Landscape Information System: Mapping Heritage Sites for Inclusive Planning"

This collaborative project, led by the National Institute of Advanced Studies (NIAS), Bangalore, aims to create a National Database of Cultural Heritage Landscapes for India. Focusing on 100 key archaeological sites, the project highlights the geospatial mapping of both protected and unprotected heritage remnants. The resulting database will enable researchers, archaeologists, and planners to make informed decisions that balance heritage preservation with sustainable urban development, ensuring India's cultural legacy is preserved for future generations. The team at Ashoka will contribute to this initiative by conducting research and preparing databases for a subset of selected sites.

**Role and Responsibilities:** The selected candidate will undergo training and work with the co-researcher of the project to achieve project deliverables, and will be based at Ashoka University, Sonepat, Haryana. Key responsibilities will include:

- Conducting research on cultural heritage sites
- Undertaking geospatial analysis and field surveys
- Collaborating with individuals and teams involved in the project

**Eligibility:** Candidates should have a Post-Graduate degree in history/ archaeology geography/ art history/ architecture/ cultural heritage/ heritage conservation/ remote sensing/ GIS/ computer science. Experience in research, remote sensing and GIS application to heritage studies, and field experience will be an asset.
